Aim of this second seminar was to gather the same – and possibly also new – representatives from villages and continue interview training on the basis of the experiences from the interviews gathered so far. The seminar was arranged by the Nenets association Yasavey and led by anthropologist Olga Murashko.

A representative from Bugrino, Yana ... has started to work but did not participate. Unfortunately, attempts to find representatives from Karatayka and Khorey-Ver have not been successful.

Olga had studied the provided interviews and maps. A number of answers to questions of the questionnaire had to be specified, and some additional information had to be placed on the maps. The interviewers possessed this information, but had not made sufficient notes. Some work was done on coordinating map symbols.

Besides Olga suggested to run a test after each interview to understand, whether all necessary information from the respondent is recorded or not. A test scheme was prepared and distributed. It was agreed that all interview results should be handed over by the end of February. To the middle of March they will be digitised.

Filipp and Aleksandr are suggested to additionally accept responsibility to collect information on Bugrino and Karatayka or find additional interviewers for these areas.

A 3rd seminar is envisaged to be carried out in March with all interviewers, again to check and verify all received information.
